

The Mariners' Park Care Home enables retired seafarers and their dependants to enjoy life to the full and retain their independence. We provide both residential care and nursing care, as well as short breaks and respite care. The Home can also support those with dementia.

The Care Home is located within the Mariners' Park Estate, where all residents are retired seafarers and their dependants. This makes for a unique location where everyone has a seafaring link and ensures friendships are made and last.

Our accommodation

Mariners' Park Care Home opened in 2002 and is modern, light and spacious. A complete refurbishment took place in 2014. There are 32 bedrooms divided into four 'households', each with their own lounge and dining area.

The lounges are comfortable and cosy, and the dining rooms all have their own drink and snackmaking facilities. There is also a large communal lounge and conservatory with a viewing deck overlooking the River Mersey and the Liverpool skyline.

The spacious bedrooms are all en suite and many have Mersey views. Each is equipped with a call bell alarm, WiFi and flat screen TV. We encourage residents to bring their own furniture and treasured possessions to make it a home from home

Our staff team

There is a qualified nurse on duty 24 hours a day and the team includes a qualified physiotherapist. The care and support of retired seafarers is our priority. Every resident agrees their own Personal Support Plan so we can provide for all your needs and wishes, and the Care Home has five 'Dignity in Care Champions'.

Dining

All meals are freshly prepared on the premises and a delicious choice of menu is always available. Whatever your dietary requirements we can ensure that you get the best choice of meals, which can be taken in the dining areas or in your own room. The Home has been awarded a level five Food Hygiene rating — the best available.

Activities

Enjoying life means continuing with hobbies and pastimes or even learning new ones. At Mariners' Park Care Home our activities coordinator will arrange a wide programme of daily activities with you including social events and trips out. There is internet access and a computer in each lounge with staff on hand to help you send an email or video-call your family and friends to keep in touch. You can also visit the unisex hairdressing salon and get yourself a new 'do'.

Outside there are the extensive gardens to enjoy including a new dementia friendly garden. If you enjoy bowls, the bowling green is always available and there is easy access to the Promenade at Egremont.
